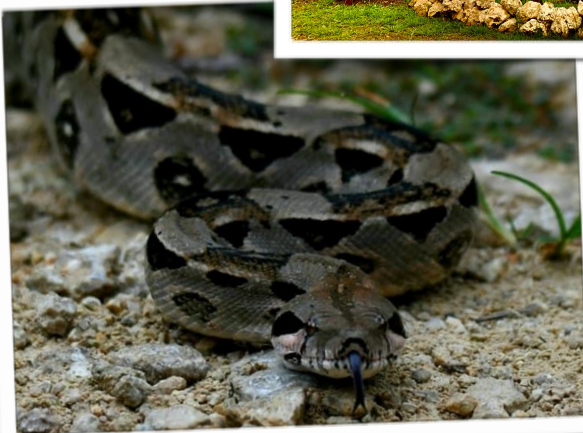
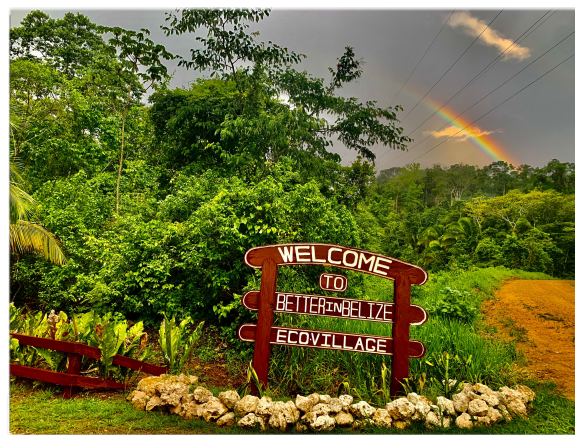

Tasks Completed



Front Gate

Lock was sprayed with graphite to fix the sticking issue. The key in the lockbox was replaced since it was about to break. A bottle of hand sanitizer was purchased to replace the empty one for anyone to use when coming or going. We are donating this purchase. A hole was drilled in the tire to prevent water collection and mosquito growth.



Medical

The backboard was picked up from Arrow Freight and along with the straps was locked in the garden shed with the other medical supplies. We will be purchasing hooks and hanging it this coming week.
