Good morning,

The EAB has inspected the Cahune palm tree. The tree still has a lot of green palm fronds at the top with many dead fronds hanging. We recommend that a wire cable be attached to the tree about 2/3 up the tree and tied to another large tree downhill and to the left. This will give the tree time to recover or die.

The cable would prevent the tree from falling on her house or the neighbors house if it does die and fall.

The recommendation at this time is to not allow the tree to be remove.




